







# Program Description

### **Module One - Safety and Tire Management**

This session provides an overview of the program and covers common factors that can affect the safe use of tires.

#### **Module Two - Personal Tire Safety**

Employees learn what they should know when choosing and maintaining tires on their personal vehicles.

#### **Module Three - Tire Selection and Limits**

The third session covers the importance of selecting the right tires for machines and operating environments.

## Module Four - Delivery, Storage and Handling of Earthmover Tires

Participants learn how to handle earthmover tires before they are mounted on a machine, including proper transportation, delivery and storage.

# Module Five - Safety Around Rim and Wheel Components

This module discusses the types of earthmover rims and wheels as well as tools used when mounting tires. Safety reminders about rim/ wheel damages and maintenance are provided.

# Module Six - Mounting, Inflation and Demounting

Program participants learn how to mount, inflate and demount an earthmover tire safely.

#### Module Seven - Haulage and TMPH

This session discusses haulage conditions and their impact on tire performance.

## **Module Eight - Tire Technology**

This module explains the function of an earthmover tire as well as the evolution of tire design and technology.

# Module Nine - Tire Inspection and Damage Assessment

This session provides instruction in inspecting an earthmover tire to assess damage and tire wear.

## **Module Ten - Tire Shop Work Environment**

This module covers maintaining a safe and productive tire shop work environment.

#### **Module Eleven - Tire Repair**

Program participants learn the intricacies of tire repair and importance of proper repair for performance and safe use of earthmover tires.

#### Module Twelve - Nitrogen Inflation and Tire Fires

The final session shows participants how to prevent and deal with tire fires as well as the basics of nitrogen inflation.
